

PROJETS DE TRAVAUX

I should like to announce the impending completion of an index verborum to the *Noctes Atticae* of Aulus Gellius. The work will be printed on an IBM 360/50 computer, and will have both upper and lower case letters in the Latin and Greek alphabets, as well as italics.

There will be a listing of every word used by Gellius, in the form in which it is found, with identification by book, chapter, and section number. The text followed was the Teubner edition of Hosius; but the readings of Peter Marshall in the new O.C.T. are noted and identified.

In addition to the basic index there will be a listing of all proper (historical) names found in the work. A list of authors mentioned, with titles, and complete quotations given, with references to the collections, following Marshall. Some of these quotations are not found in the standard compilations of fragments. There will be a listing of all legal material mentioned or quoted -- i.e., *leges*, *plebiscita*, *senatus consulta*, as well as all references to the *XII Tabulae*. *Leges*, etc., that are published will be referred to in the proper collections, following Marshall's O.C.T. For antiquarian interest, there will be a collation of "proverbial sayings" noted by Gellius.

The entire text has been punched on IBM cards, coded to isolate the material noted above, proofread once, and corrected, and is now being proofread for the second time. The program is in preparation. Completion date is hoped to be summer, 1970.
